EUROPEAN PIANO COMPETITION “SONJA PAHOR”

REGULATIONS

ART. 1

The European Piano Competition "Sonja Pahor" is open to all European musicians.

ART. 2

The Competition will take place on media platform

ART.3

The candidates will be divided into the following categories:

- Junior (born from 2014 onwards) free program with a maximum duration of 5’
- A (born from 2011 to 2013) free program with a maximum duration of 7’
- B (born from 2008 to 2010) free program with a maximum duration of 10’
- C (born from 2005 to 2007) free program with a maximum duration of 15’
- D (born from 1998 to 2004) free program with a maximum duration of 20’
- E (born from 1992 to 1997) free program with a maximum duration of 30’

ART. 4

The competitors can enter a category higher than their age.

The Jury reserves the right to stop competitors who exceed the time indicated in article 3.

The execution from memory is not obligatory.

ART. 5

Facilitated versions are not allowed. The transcripts will instead be admitted at the discretion of the jury.

The applicants will have to send a copy of the pieces to be played.

ART. 6

The Jury will be composed of world-renowned musicians. The members of the Jury may not present either relatives or students with whom they have in place or have had didactic relationships in the two years preceding the beginning of the competition. Each member of the Jury will issue a statement on his situation towards competitors in relation to the above.

ART. 7

Competitors will be rated with a score ranging from 1 to 100 and the vote will be determined by the average resulting from the votes of all members of the Jury, excluding the lowest and highest grades.

The Jury’s decisions are irrevocable and not subject to appeal.

The results will be published on the website www.concorsosonjapahor.com and on the facebook page “Concorso Musicale Sonja Pahor” by July 15th 2022

ART. 8

All applicants are required to submit the attached application form. Applications should be sent **no later than June 5th, 2022** to the following address e-mail: info@concorsosonjapahor.com.

A non-refundable application fee is required. It should be sent by bank account addressed to: Associazione Musicale Nuovo Trio Parsifal IBAN n° **IT59F0760103200001006918682**. The receipt of the payment, a photocopy of an identity document, and copy of the scores in pdf format should be attached to the application form.

The applications fees, as a contribution for the costs of organization, are as follows:

Junior Category € 30.00

Categories A – B – C € 40.00

Categories D – E € 50.00

Incomplete applications as well as applications which not include the receipt of payment, will not be considered. The registration at the competition will imply full acceptance of all of its regulations and the consent to make public participants' videos.

The author in presenting the videos, automatically declares their authenticity.

Mandatory video features:

- The shot must be fixed, without cuts or audio / video editing during the entire execution (no cuts between each piece, no cuts between the presentation and the execution).
- In the video the competitor must be clearly visible, so as to allow identification and to avoid penalty of exclusion from the competition procedure
- The video will have to start with a presentation during which the competitor, showing his face, will pronounce his first name, his last name, his date of birth, the execution program, the full name of the competition (Piano Competition Sonja Pahor) and category.
- The video can be made with any device or other support for video shooting
- The videos must be uploaded on a Youtube channel. Uploading to YouTube can be done with a "public" video privacy setting (open to anyone) or with an "unlisted" setting (visible to anyone with the link)

ART. 9

- Each competitor who has a score of at least 95/100 will be awarded with a diploma of 1st prize and a cup.
- Each competitor who has a score between 90/100 and 94/100 will be awarded with a diploma of 2nd prize and a medal.
- Each competitor who has a score between 85/100 and 89/100 will be awarded with a diploma of 3rd prize and a medal.
- Any competitor who has a score of no less than 80/100 will be issued with a diploma of merit with score.
- All competitors will be issued with a certificate of participation.
- The first-placed competitor in each category with a score of no less than 98/100 will be awarded with a diploma of first overall prize and a cup.

The following prizes will also be awarded to the first overall winners:

Cat. A cash prize of €150.00

Cat. B cash prize of €200.00

Cat. C cash prize of €250.00

Cat. D cash prize of €300.00

Cat. E cash prize of €500.00 plus 1 concert and the recording of a professional master offered by Corrado Productions

"Sonja Pahor" Special Prize consisting of a cash prize and a silver plaque will be awarded to the competitor who will have demonstrated particular musical sensitivity.

For premium concerts, only reimbursement of expenses is guaranteed. Any compensation will be agreed with the organising associations.

Teachers whose pupils have been awarded will be awarded with a diploma of honor.
